- Caring for military families who suffer under the strain of the current expeditionary operational environment, including expanding and subsidizing conference center opportunities.
- Creating intentional partnerships among OCF, military chapels, and local churches, some of which utilize OCF's conference centers.
- Continuing ministry by and to OCF's many seasoned military retirees.
- Reproducing itself across generations by enabling its members to come alongside, mentor, and encourage current and future generations.

#### OCF'S NEXT DECADE?

OCF sees new facilities and increased membership with conference facilities where more families experience Christ's love and where they are equipped and encouraged for leadership. OCF sees mature leaders establishing more local fellowships. OCF sees a transforming community of emboldened believers with a passion for God and compassion for others, and a ministry positioned to serve future generations.

### TO WHAT DOES MY PLEDGE COMMIT ME?

# WHY HAVE THE EARLIER SPRING CANYON ESTIMATES GONE UP?

Earlier estimates made 6-7 years ago were preliminary and informal. The current costs were developed by a professional design team, including an architect and cost estimator, and take into account the stringent state code requirements.

# WHAT HAS BEEN OCF'S EXPERIENCE IN RAISING THESE KINDS OF FUNDS?

OCF has found God faithful in providing needed resources. The purchases of the two conference centers and the WSS Caleb project have all been stretches of faith that were successfully met. Most recently, the Lord has blessed OCF with \$7.8 million pledged or given to complete the Heritage House at WSS.

#### Do These Facility Dollars Include Furnishings And Equipment?

Yes, they are included in the projected amount. However, there will still be opportunities to accessorize individual rooms in honor of individuals or organizations.

#### OCF HISTORY



Officers' Christian Fellowship was founded during World War II as Officers' Christian Union, to bring together Christian officers, help all ranks come to a knowledge of Jesus Christ, and stimulate prayer, Bible study and Christian witness.

With over 15,000 members today, OCF groups meet at military installations around the world to encourage and equip each other for effective ministry to the entire military society. Many leaders within these groups have been emboldened at OCF conference centers at White Sulphur Springs in Pennsylvania and Spring Canyon in Colorado.

#### **OCF VISION**

"To be a dynamic community of Christian military leaders, integrating faith and profession, serving with a passion for God and a calling to the military."

#### OCF MEMBERSHIP

Regular members include active duty, retired, and former military officers. Associate members include spouses, other military personnel, and civilians who pray for, support, and co-labor in achieving the OCF purpose and vision.

OCF conference centers are critical to sustaining and expanding the ministry. They are an integral part of OCF's outreach, providing military men and women with a place where their faith can grow in an atmosphere of community and fellowship. With this experience, they are equipped and motivated to go out and become leaders in their families and fellowships.

Because military families move frequently, they seldom put down deep roots in a community. At the conference centers they can develop a sense of belonging they could not otherwise enjoy. In addition to this feeling of "coming home," the centers provide a wide range of supportive programs, including summer and winter camps and retreats for families, ROTC and academy groups. Many military families call White Sulphur Springs and Spring Canyon "home."

Limited, outdated, and aging facilities are constraining the effectiveness of these conference centers. OCF is addressing these critical needs in this campaign.

The Heritage House at White Sulphur Springs, upon completion in April 2011, will effectively double the guest capacity at OCF's eastern conference center.



Funds are now being sought to expand capabilities at Spring Canyon, OCF's western conference center, so that more groups could be served, particularly during the high season.

#### EXPANSION PROJECTS AT SPRING CANYON

- \* Hemingway Operations Complex supporting outdoor programs including Rocky Mountain High and Father Teen Adventure (completed).
- \* Two new lodges with 8 family-sized guest rooms each that will significantly increase guest capacity at Spring Canyon.
- \* Expansion of Hartley Holmes Lodge dining room and a new larger kitchen that will accommodate 200 guests/campers.
- \* Required central waste water treatment.

\* Expansion costs: \$3.5 million.
